PARENT/GUARDIAN STATEMENT

Required for all students:

Custody disputes are handled by the courts. Schools have no legal jurisdiction to refuse a parent access to their student or to their student's school record without a court order specifically limiting the parent's access. Any custody, restraining, or other court orders must be provided to the school. The order must be stamped, dated, and signed by a judge. When such orders are received, appropriate school staff will be notified and the student's records will be updated. Should any such situation become a disruption to the school, law enforcement will be contacted.

PARENTS ARE ASKED TO MAKE EVERY ATTEMPT NOT TO INVOLVE SCHOOL SITES IN CUSTODY MATTERS.
