#### NPHS Course Selection Guidelines

Schedule changes will **not** be made to accommodate teacher requests, period requests, extracurricular or athletic activities.

A required schedule change will be made for a student who failed a course or who completed a pre-approved summer school course.

A requested schedule change will be made only if it improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college entrance requirements AND if there is space available. Schedule change requests can be addressed in August during Schedule Pick-Up Day.

#### Athletics

If you play a NPHS team sport, you will earn 5 credits each season toward your 20-credit PE requirement. If you play a NPHS team sport as a freshman, are not required to take PE 9. Your sport will be added to your schedule (as a period 7) after your coach adds you to a team roster. If you intend to play a NCAA/NAIA sport in college, it is **your** responsibility to review the following eligibility requirements:

#### **Prerequisites**

#### Honors Placement

If you are CURRENTLY taking an honors course in your intended honors subject, and if you are earn a B or higher as your final grade, you may choose the next sequential honors course. If you are NOT currently taking an honors course in your intended subject, you must earn an A in all final marking periods. If you do not earn an A in all final marking periods, you need to complete an Academic Waiver Form.
