#### **NPHS Course Selection Guidelines**

Schedule changes will **not** be made to accommodate teacher requests, period requests, extracurricular or athletic activities.

A required schedule change will be made for a student who failed a course or who completed a pre-approved summer school course.

A requested schedule change will be made only if it improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college entrance requirements AND if there is space available. Schedule change requests can be addressed in August during Schedule Pick-Up Day.

#### **Athletics**

If you play a NPHS team sport, you will earn 5 credits each season toward your 20-credit PE requirement. ## Prerequisites

If you do not earn an A in all final marking periods, you need to complete an Academic Waiver Form .
