NPHS Course Selection Guidelines

Schedule changes will not be made to accommodate teacher requests, period requests, extracurricular or athletic activities.

A required schedule change will be made for a student who failed a course or who completed a pre-approved summer school course.

A requested schedule change will be made only if it improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college entrance requirements AND if there is space available. Schedule change requests can be addressed in August during Schedule Pick-Up Day.

Athletics

If you play a NPHS team sport, you will earn 5 credits each season toward your 20-credit PE requirement. Your sport will be added to your schedule (as a period 7) after your coach adds you to a team roster. For Athletic information, visit: www.nphsathletics.org . Prerequisites
