Course Description:

College Preparatory (CP) United States History fulfills both state and district requirements for high school graduation. The course examines the nation's history from approximately the time of the Industrial Revolution, with an emphasis on the Twentieth Century. Instruction is centered not on merely memorizing the events of American history, but on teaching students to critically analyze history in order to determine how the nation's past has influenced the present. Occasionally, the study of current events in American society will be infused through the curriculum in order to highlight connections to standards.
