

COURSE TITLE: Eco Art

Course Description:

This course is designed to introduce students to a new way of creating art that minimizes impact on the environment by having them assemble and render their pieces with primarily repurposed/natural materials. Students will learn the history of eco/repurposed art which will be explored throughout the course. Students will apply these artistic concepts to their project ideas.

Students will plan, select, find and use their own materials based on the lesson and project requirements to produce a finished product.

*Students will be expected to use various types of tools including but not limited to:

X-acto knives, box cutters, hammers, and hot glue guns.

Materials: art kit from previous art classes listed in prerequisites.

Grading:

30% of the student's grade comes from "Practice Work" (sketchbook, in class practice exercises, etc.).

50% of the student's grade comes from "Projects," which are major projects.

20% of the student's grade comes from "Work Habits," which includes the student's ability to use the valuable class time and resources wisely.
