- 3% Black

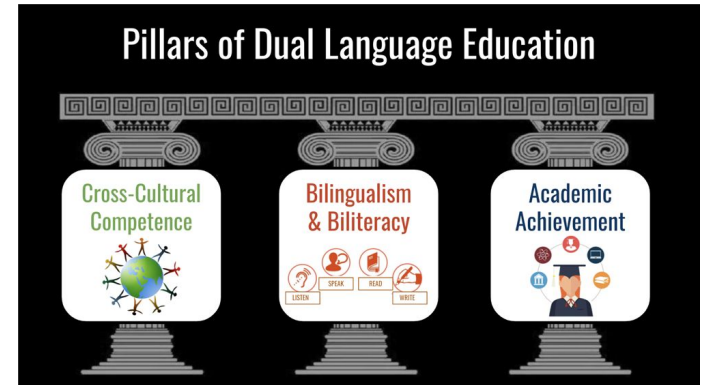
Multilingual Learners

Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program

- Direct language and academic instruction in English and Spanish
- Additive Learning
- Start in Early Grades
- Language Balance
- Bilingualism, Biliteracy and Bicultural



Benefits of Dual Language Immersion

- **Educational:**
 - Comparable or higher academic achievement than English-only programs
 - Both English-only and English Learner students show improved academic outcomes in math and reading in elementary grades
 - Increased metalinguistic awareness and critical thinking
- **Sociocultural:**
 - Increased empathy and perspective by promoting cultural awareness
- **Economic:**
 - Increased career opportunities and compensation across both private and public sectors
 - 5% to 20% salary increase compared to Monolingual Peers



Research on DLI Programs

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Program 1: Two-way developmental bilingual education (BE)

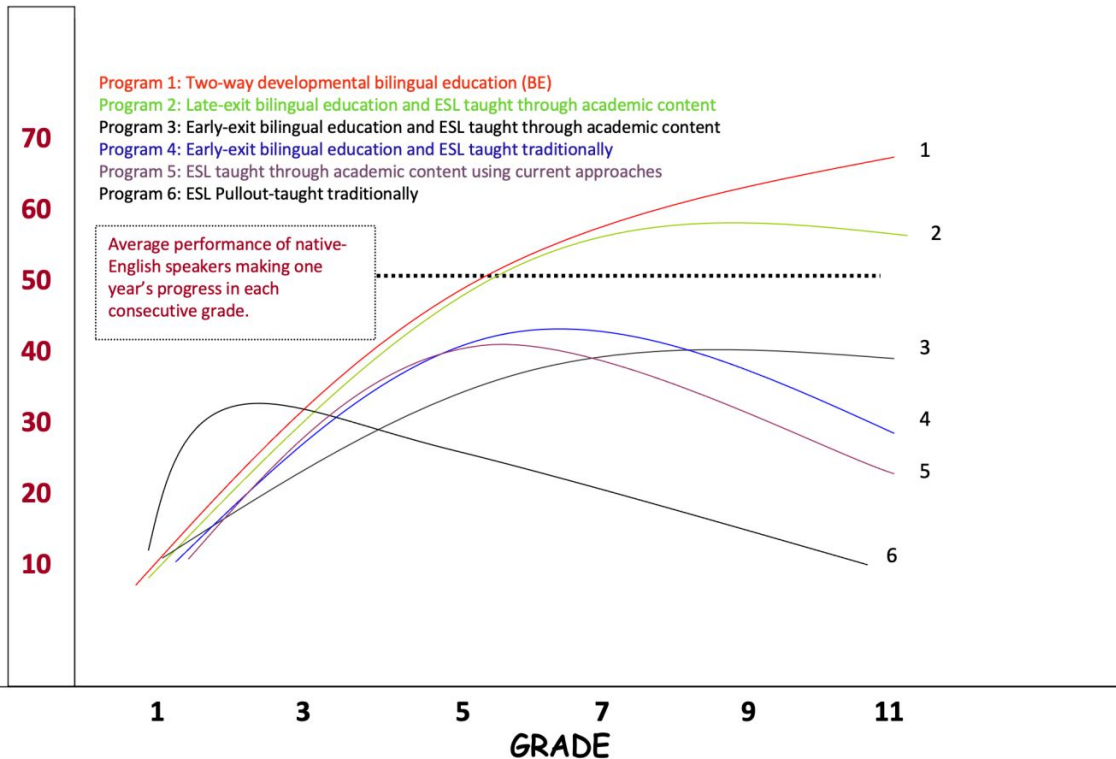
Program 2: Late-exit bilingual education and ESL taught through academic content

Program 3: Early-exit bilingual education and ESL taught through academic content

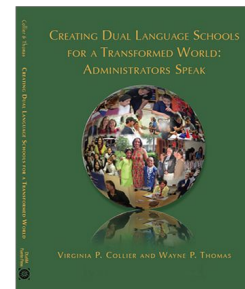
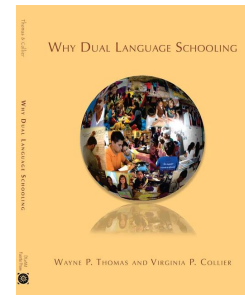
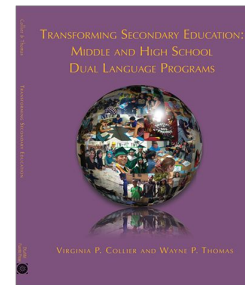
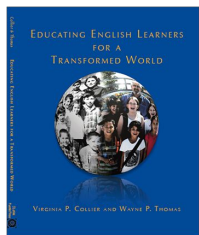
Program 4: Early-exit bilingual education and ESL taught traditionally

Program 6: ESL Pullout-taught traditionally

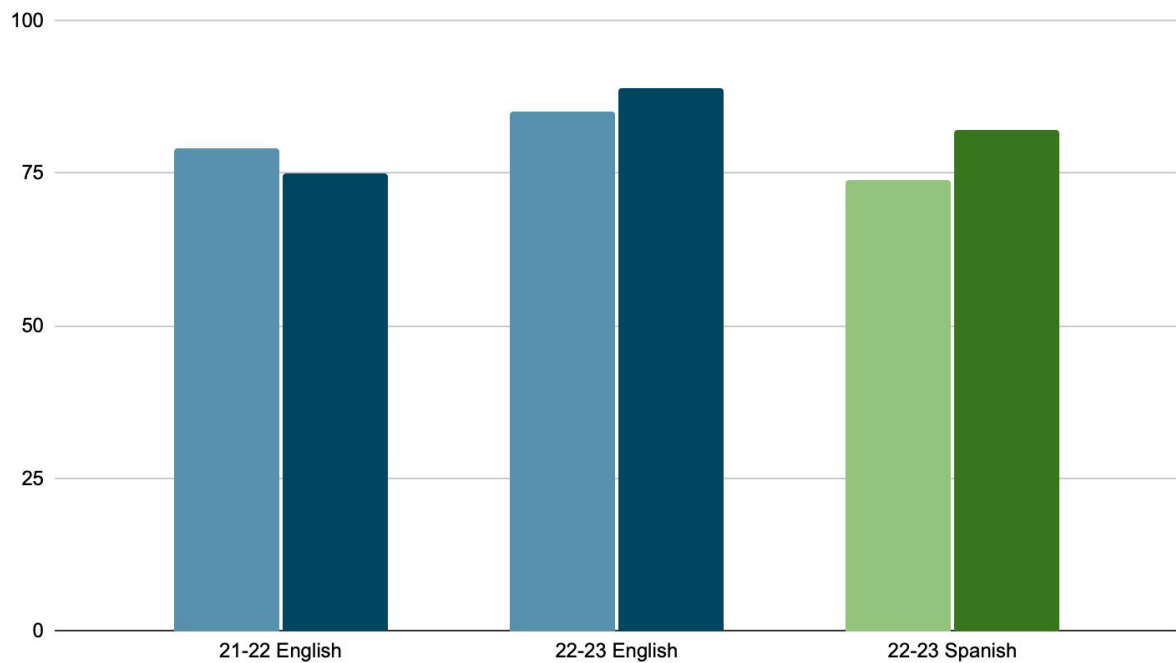


Average performance of native-English speakers making one year's progress in each consecutive grade.



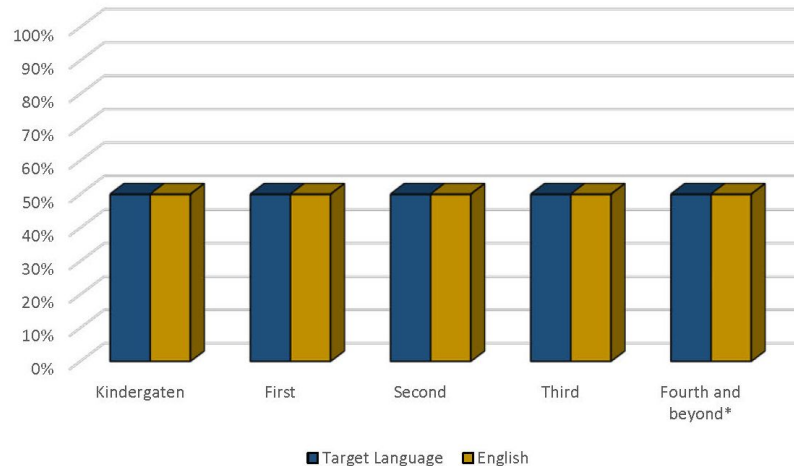

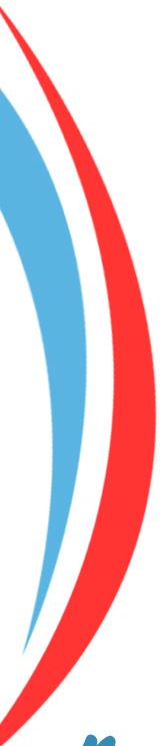

Dual Language Immersion 50:50 Model

- Balance amount of time allocated to teach the state standards in each language
- Each subsequent grade level will remain a split of 50% Spanish and 50% English
- Skills are not re-taught in both languages, but rather built upon in each language





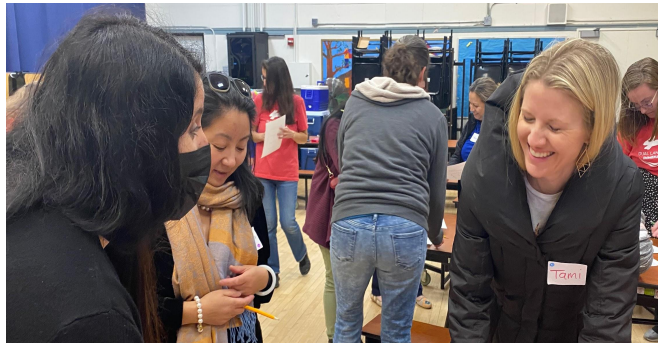

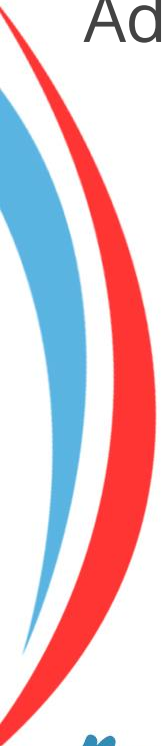

DLI Enrollment Procedures and Requirements

- Balance of primary languages among the students is necessary
 - Spanish primary
 - English primary
 - Established bilingual
- Six (6-7) year enrollment commitment (TK-5th grade)
- Three (3) ways to enroll:
 - Neighborhood school (starts January 30, 2024)
 - CVUSD school choice (starts Nov 1, 2023)
 - Inter-district transfer (starts Nov 1, 2023)
- Neighborhood families receive priority but not guaranteed admission
- School choice notifications start in early spring based on language balance and availability
