1. CLOSED SESSION

2. OPEN SESSION

A. Call the Meeting to Order and Roll Call

Call to Order and Roll Call: President Connolly called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Board Members present: President Connolly, Cindy Goldberg, and Jenny Fitzgerald. Mrs. Everett and Mr. Gorback were absent.

Administration present: Dr. Mark McLaughlin, Superintendent; Victor Hayek, Deputy Superintendent, Business Services; Jeanne Valentine, Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources; Lou Lichtl, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services and Lisa Miller, Assistant Superintendent, Student Support Services.

B. Pledge of Allegiance

President Connolly asked for a moment of silence after the pledge of allegiance in remembrance of a student in our District that recently lost his life to an accident.

President Connolly announced that the following items were discussed in Closed Session:

The Board discussion included the following questions/statements:

- Why is the location of the Independent Study Program not a right fit for Century? Mr. Lichtle answered that there were issues with space, and that Conejo Valley High could allocate space for classes during the school day due to the staffing ratio and the current student schedules.
- Did the District meet with the Independent Study students? If not, that should be done to get the students' perspective on the move.

President Connolly announced that there was one comment card:

 Speaker 1 spoke in support of the move of the Special Education Department to the District Office.

The Board continued their discussion with the following questions/statements:

- Will the students and families in the BreakThrough Program have access to the restrooms in the B Building? Dr. McLaughlin answered yes.
- Will these be final moves for most departments? Dr. McLaughlin answered that this should be the final move because this structure makes sense.
- How often do parents visit the Transportation and Child Nutrition Departments? Dr. Hayek
 answered that parent visitation is consistent throughout the year, with busy times over the
 summer and into October. Dr. McLaughlin stated that the online service will require less inperson visitations. Visitor parking will be designated in the front of the building, and parents
 can also complete their paperwork on the computer in the lobby of the District Office.
- Is it realistic to assume that everything will be ready for the start of this school year? Dr. Hayek answered that everything won't be finished by the start of school, but the majority will be done.
- I. Budget/LCAP Committee Update by: Dr. Victor Hayek, Deputy Superintendent, Business Services, Mr. Luis Lichtl, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services, and Lisa Miller, Assistant Superintendent, Student Support Services

Dr. Hayek, Mr. Lichtl and Ms. Miller presented an update on the Budget/LCAP Committee that included discussion on LCAP and budget alignment and implementation, stakeholder feedback and engagement, LCAP focus areas, LCAP and SPSA alignment, progress monitoring, site goals, indepth data analysis, budgetary guidance and future initiatives.

The budget discussion included information on the budget cycle and reporting for next year, current year and prior year, the economic outlook for California, May revise updates, changes from second interim, 2019-2020 assumptions, lack of one-time funds, staff discussion on expense reductions, and proposed next steps, alternatives, expectations and suggestions.

The Board discussion included the following questions/statements:

- Board member requested information on the school site breakdown and the percentage of survey respondents for the current year versus the last three years. Dr. McLaughlin confirmed that the District does have information broken down by each school site, but hasn't presented it that way in the past. He will send this information to the Board through Board reports and to the community in future years.
- Suggestion to give responding parents the opportunity to indicate whether their student receives any special services.
- Is there a way to increase survey participation or find out why parents aren't participating?
