Scholastic BookFlix is an online literacy resource that pairs classic video storybooks with related nonfiction eBooks to build a love of reading and learning. Linking fact and fiction, BookFlix reinforces early reading skills, and introduces topic exploration. Interactive reading includes read-along options, fiction/ nonfiction pairs, definitions and narrated text support, educational games, and author biographies. Grades K - 5.

Brainfuse HelpNow! offers live, online homework help from a Brainfuse tutor, skills building services to help students master a concept through tutoring and statealigned online lessons, and a 24/7 Help Center for students to submit a homework question that is answered by a tutor within 24 hours. Students can also create their



own flashcards and multiple choice quizzes for self-study on both computers and mobile devices. Brainwave is a tool that allows you to record a movie of your activity on the Brainfuse whiteboard, whether it's for solving a problem or for a fun presentation. HelpNow is available for K-Adult Learners.



Britannica Library Children includes thousands of images, videos, and statistics to research virtually any topic. Other resources include research guides, learning activities for English & language arts, the sciences, the

Social Sciences, timelines on various topics, and an online dictionary and thesaurus. K-8th Grade.
