



At Conejo Valley High School, our focus will continue to be on supporting our students in both an academic and a social-emotional capacity. Credit recovery continues to be paramount for our students. CVHS student will be enrolled in two (2) courses at a time and one (1) course that is either enrichment, advisory or credit recovery.

- Due to COVID-19 cases and concerns, splitting the semester course-load enhances health and safety by reducing the number of overall contacts for students and staff when CVUSD returns to on-campus (Blended) learning.
- Students will cover the same material per semester as they would in a typical semester AND have the opportunity to recover units in a credit recovery model of a continuation school.
- CVHS will continue to have small student to teacher ratios.
- Enrollment in 2 courses in a given period of time will allow CVHS students the advantage of building stronger connections with their peers and teachers, and will allow for a greater emphasis on the social emotional wellbeing of students to take place.

The additional enrichment/advisory/credit recovery period enables students to ask questions and get feedback directly from their teachers, and complete additional work to recovery lost credits.
