CVUSD Information Letter Regarding 6CP Boost Exam/Camp

Dear Parent/Guardian,

In spring of 2015, the Conejo Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) aligned the math courses of study and math pathways to the California State Standards. The standards realigned concepts within the overall mathematics progression for our state. Our teachers have worked diligently to ensure that our students have the opportunity to transition to the new standards without allowing gaps in their learning. These pathways will allow your student opportunities to achieve the highest levels of math in high school and beyond.

The CVUSD math pathway, displayed on the back of this letter and located on our District website <http://www.conejousd.org/Departments/Instructional-Services/Middle-School-Education-and-Professional-Learning/Middle-School-Curriculum>, delineates the CVUSD Math Pathway for the 2019-2020 school year. This new state standards pathway does not allow students to go from Math 6CP to Math 7 Accelerated (Math 7A) directly. Students will need concepts found in Math 7CP, to be successful in Math 7A. Students receiving an A at each marking period in Math 6CP will be eligible for our district's Boost Camp. The Boost Camp is a cost-free summer school opportunity from June 12 to June 27, 2019 from **8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** at Thousand Oaks High School to gain the additional skills necessary for Math 7A. You will need to provide your own transportation to Boost Camp.

Congratulations! You are receiving this letter because your child qualifies for the free Boost Camp!

If your child is unable to attend the Boost Camp they will have the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge on an exam of the Math 7CP standards. The exams will take place on Monday, June 10, 2019 at Madrona Elementary School or Thursday June 27, 2019 at Thousand Oaks High School. Both tests have limited space, please register early to secure your spot. Students must pass with a 70% or above. Therefore, the prerequisite for students to move from Math 6CP to Math 7A is successful completion of the Boost Camp with a 70% on the boost camp exam.
