Students

Student Leave of Absence

***Note: Education Code 48232 and 48416 mandate the Board to adopt policy if it wishes to grant student leaves of absence. This policy and related administrative regulation may be revised if the Board wishes to grant such leave only for regular students or only for continuation education students. ***

Upon request, the Governing Board may grant student leaves of absence in accordance with law for the purpose of supervised travel, study, training, or work not available to the student under another educational option. Such leave may be granted to a student fifteen (15) years of age or older in the regular program and to a student between the ages of sixteen (16) and eighteen (18) in the continuation program.

No more than one percent of the students enrolled and attending a school shall be granted a leave of absence during any school year. (Education Code 48232, 48416)

When feasible, students shall be encouraged to instead enroll in the district's independent study program to allow for greater contact and coordination with district staff.
