# California Healthy Youth Act (CHYA)

Enacted January 1, 2016, this law integrates the instruction of comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education.

The bill requires school districts to ensure that all pupils in grades seven to twelve, inclusive, receive comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education.

<b>Article 2</b> <u><a href="#">51933-51934</a></u>	<i>Required Comprehensive Sexual Health and HIV Prevention Education</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Specific topics required to be taught as part of comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education</li></ul>
<b>Article 3</b> <u><a href="#">51935-51936</a></u>	<i>In-Service Training</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Training for personnel providing HIV prevention education</li><li>• Districts may contract with outside consultants or guest speakers</li></ul>
<b>Article 4</b> <u><a href="#">51937-51939</a></u>	<i>Notice &amp; Parental Excusal</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Parent/guardian has right to excuse child from all or part of comprehensive sexual health and HIV prevention education through a passive consent (“opt-out”) process</li></ul>

# CHYA: Timeline of What's Been Accomplished

- Presentations to Board on August 20, 2019 and October 15, 2019
- Opt-out process approved on August 20, 2019
- Staff met with high school health teachers on November 13, 2019, December 17, 2019, January 27, 2020
  - Conducted audit of CHYA and currently adopted high school health materials
  - Reviewed the following curriculum: *Be Real Be Ready, Heart, Positive Prevention Plus, Rights Respect Responsibility*
  - Decision to create supplemental Grade 9 Health materials
  - Proposing supplemental presentations to the Board
