Combination Class Pilot

Combination classes include:

- Students attending in-class instruction on campus with their teacher and peers, and
- Classmates attending simultaneously via Zoom

Combination Pilot Classes

Update on Combo Pilot Classes

<u>School Site</u>	<u>Combo Classes</u>	<u>Number of Students on campus</u>
Century	22	110 students total (No more than 45 students on campus at any given period of time)
CVHS	2 (CTE courses)	37 students (total)**
NPHS	16	140 students (total)
TOHS	9	90 students (total)
WHS	14	150 students (total)

**Inclusive of CTE, combo courses and intervention period

Combination Pilot Classes

Implementation:

- Site administration collaborated with staff
- Courses will roll out over time
- Staff professional development is forthcoming
- Providing technical support in classrooms to facilitate teaching

Combination Pilot Classes

Staff Feedback

- Most common response - “It’s nice to be back on campus”
- Well managed systems and safety procedures
- Many teachers report that they want more students to attend
- Working with site techs regarding technology and efficiency

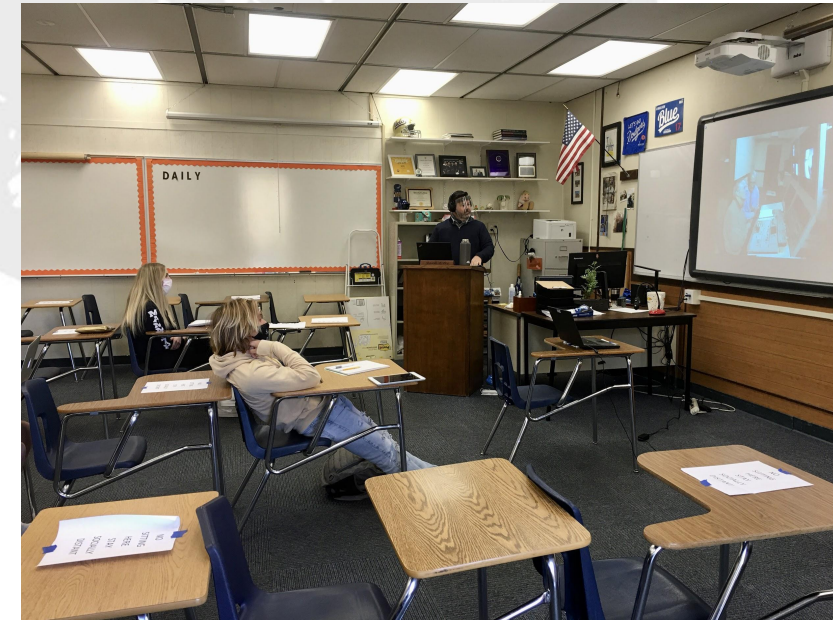

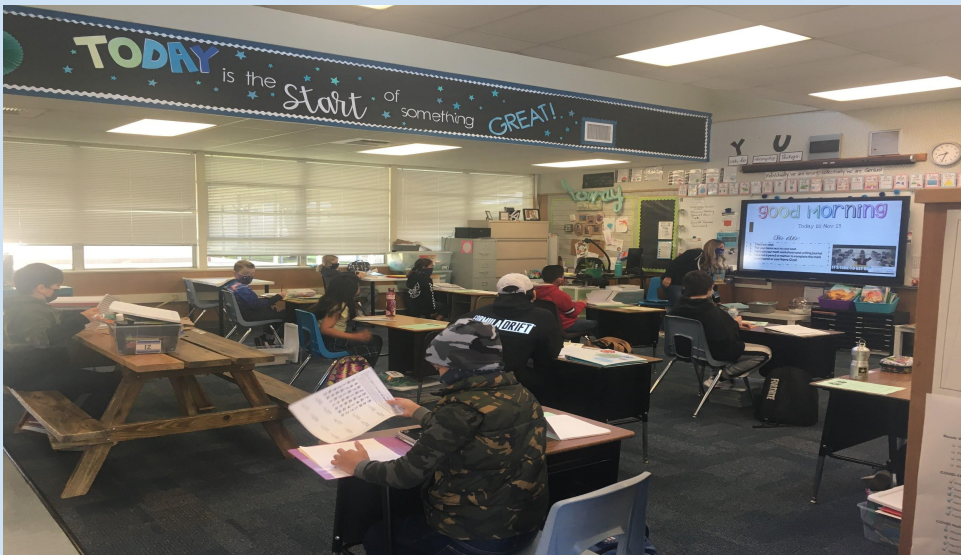
