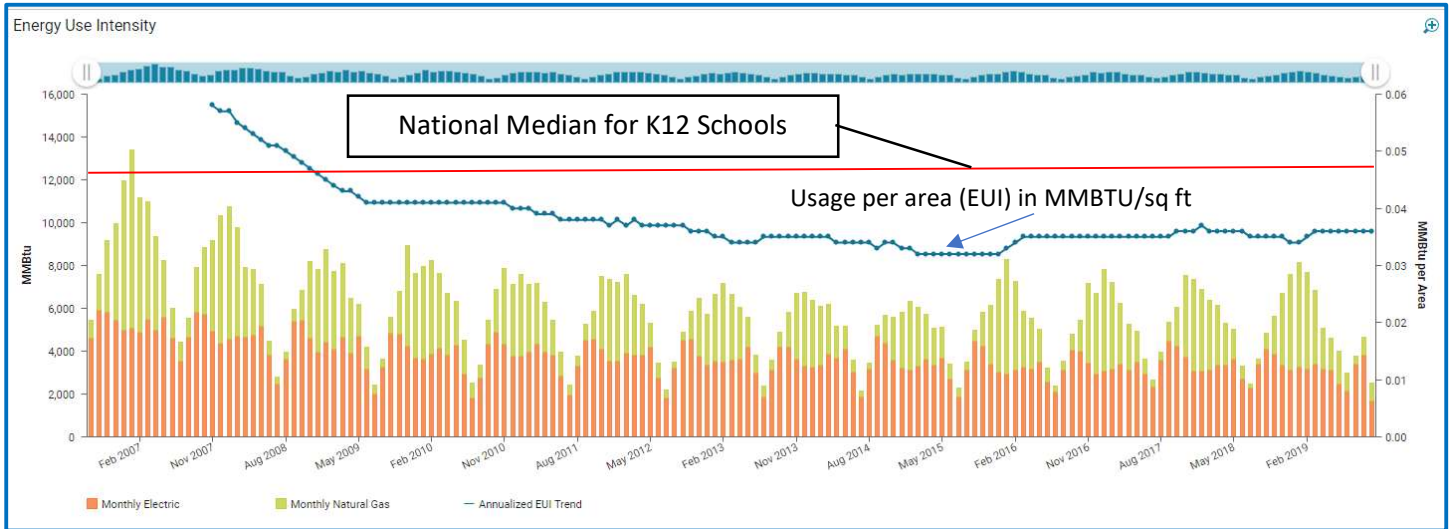


CVUSD Energy Use Intensity (EUI):



The most common unit of measurement for energy management is Energy Use Intensity (EUI). The U.S. EPA Energy Star Program defines EIO as: "The energy consumed by a building relative to its size." This Energy Trend, or EUI Chart, shows monthly normalized energy usage for electricity and gas, in global energy units of BTU's per square foot of building space.

The blue trend line shows the running average of the prior 12 months. We strive to see a blue line that over time trends downward to the right, meaning that the EIO is improving (lower is better; energy intensity is declining).
